

# Audience Passes for the 41st Warsaw Film Festival

We are pleased to open the sale of **Audience Passes**, which allow you to book tickets for festival screenings through your personal “**My Festival**” account at [wff.pl](http://wff.pl).

## How to purchase a pass?

1. Fill in the form and submit your order.
2. Wait for your application to be verified.
3. Complete the payment once your order is confirmed.

The number of passes is **limited** – first come, first served.

## Rules for Audience Passes at the Warsaw Film Festival

The 41st Warsaw Film Festival will take place on October 10–19, 2025 in cinemas across Warsaw.

### WHAT IS AN AUDIENCE PASS?

An Audience Pass for the Warsaw Film Festival is a personalized ID card that entitles its holder to collect free tickets for film screenings held as part of the Festival in Warsaw.

### PRICE AND PURCHASE

- Price of the pass: 500 PLN
- Passes can only be purchased online via the Festival's website: [www.wff.pl](http://www.wff.pl)
- Sales continue until September 15, 2025, or until the pool is sold out.
- Passes are personal and non-transferable — they cannot be given to another person.
- Passes are non-refundable, unless the Festival dates change due to reasons beyond the organizer's control.

### COLLECTING YOUR PASS

- Passes will be available for collection from October 9, 2025, at the Festival Center located at Kino ATLANTIC, from 10:30 am to 8:00 pm.
- The pass can only be collected by the person it was issued to (with valid ID) or by an authorized representative holding proof of purchase.

### HOW TO USE THE PASS DURING THE FESTIVAL

- The pass entitles the holder to collect one ticket for a selected screening (for the same day or the following day).
- Tickets can be reserved via [www.wff.pl](http://www.wff.pl) starting at 7:00 am the day before the chosen screening, and no later than 60 minutes before it begins.
- One hour before each screening, any uncollected tickets from the accreditation/pass pool will be released for online sale.
- Tickets are stored in the accreditation system and verified upon entry to the cinema hall by scanning the accreditation code.
- The pass does not grant admission to the Opening Gala, Awards Gala, or any special events requiring separate invitations or tickets.
- The number of seats available to pass holders is limited — tickets are issued on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Each film can only be seen once with a single pass.
- Transferring the pass to third parties is strictly prohibited.
- Pass holders without a ticket may be admitted from the *last minute line* if seats remain available in the hall.
