

## INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

- 1. The controller of your personal data is the Warszawska Fundacja Filmowa (Warsaw Film Foundation) with its registered office at ul. Lwowska 11/11, 00-660 Warsaw, Poland, entered in the Register of Associations Other Social and Professional Organisations Foundations and Public Health Care Institutions kept by the District Court for the Capital City of Warsaw in Warsaw, 12th Commercial Division of the National Court Register under KRS number 0000110269, NIP 521-22-21-961, REGON 011132954; email: <a href="mailto:biuro@wff.pl">biuro@wff.pl</a>.
- 2. The Controller has appointed a Data Protection Officer (DPO) for matters related to the processing of personal data: **Agata Szymańska**, **biuro@wff.pl**.
- 3. To conduct the accreditation process, the following personal data will be processed: a) first and last name, b) date of birth, c) passport number or other identity document number, d) email address, e) country of residence, f) telephone number, g) occupation, h) gender.
- 4. Your personal data will be processed for the following purposes: a) to verify your application and issue the accreditation you ordered for the 41st edition of the Warsaw International Film Festival in 2025, b) to enable the use of the accreditation during the Festival based on Article 6(1)(b) GDPR, c) in the event of claims related to your participation in the accreditation process based on Article 6(1)(f) GDPR, to pursue the Controller's legitimate interests consisting in the establishment, exercise, or defence of claims connected with participation in the accreditation process.
- 5. Your data may be disclosed to entities providing services to the Controller in connection with the technical and organisational support of the Festival and to entities providing services related to your participation in the Festival, such as hotel or transport services.
- 6. The data you provide will be stored for the period necessary to achieve the purposes indicated in point 4 and thereafter for no longer than six years from the end of the event to comply with legal obligations and for the establishment, exercise, or defence of claims.
- 7. You have the right at any time to request access to your data, rectification, erasure, restriction of processing, and data portability.
- 8. You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data.
- 9. You have the right to complain to the President of the Personal Data Protection Office (Prezes Urzędu Ochrony Danych Osobowych) in connection with the processing of your personal data.
- 10. Providing your personal data is voluntary; however, it is necessary for participation in the Festival.
- 11. Your personal data will not be processed by automated means and will not be subject to profiling.
